- · Roving vendors
- · Costumed individuals without permits

The Street Fair Committee reserves the right to deny any application that does not conform to these guidelines.

THERE IS NO RAIN DATE: Every effort will be made to have the fair. If the weather causes the fair to be canceled, there will be **no rain date or refunds**.

- Every vendor must obtain the appropriate insurance.
- Vendor space is limited, available spaces are issued on a first-come basis, it is urged that you submit your application with payment today!
- Space availability after July 1 cannot be guaranteed (no refund will be made for any reason).
- Applications and payment received AFTER August 31 incurs a \$50 late fee. Payments made after September 12 MUST be CASH or MONEY ORDER ONLY.
- Day of event registration and payment incurs a \$100 late fee and registration fee accepted as CASH ONLY.
- NO EXCEPTIONS.

Welcome to the Rotary/Kiwanis Caldwell Street Fair!

A substantial area on Bloomfield Avenue in the center of Caldwell will be blocked off, with the provisions for adequate parking in the area. In the even of rain, the fair will be canceled at 8:00 AM. Call 551-206-3951 after 8:00 AM.

The co-sponsors have made every effort to maximize the attendance at the Fair, and it is anticipated that the day will be profitable for all. We have had consistently in excess of 30,000 attendees over the years.

Spaces are available for over 200 crafters, new merchandise and food concessions as well as children's amusement rides.

Vendors spaces (excluding food truck vendors) measure 15 feet wide by 10 feet deep and we reserve the right to reclassify your category.

Set-up and Clean-up

NO EARLIER THAN 9:00 AM and conclude by 11:00 AM with take down at 5:15 PM. We ask that you bring your own tables and displays. Electricity is available upon request in designated areas at \$100.00 per hook-up.

ALL merchants are required to have appropriate trash collection capabilities and are required to clean up their area after the event.

Cancellation

If weather, any government restrictions, COVID-19 pandemic or any other casualty or cause beyond our control causes the fair to be cancelled, modified or limited in a way where you will not be able to participate, there will be no new date or refunds.

Conformance

All vendors at the Street Fair are required and expected to review, follow and abide by all Federal, State and local government laws, ordinances, policies, guidelines, rules, regulations, orders and restrictions that are in place at the time of the Street Fair concerning or relating to the COVID-19 pandemic. Any vendor found not to be in compliance with any Federal, State and/or local government laws, ordinances, policies, guidelines, rules, regulations, orders or restrictions will be shut down and removed from the Street Fair immediately.

Sell Only Arts & Crafts

Any vendor offering a combination of arts & crafts and new merchandise will be reassigned as a \$175 new merchandise vendor.
